

About this Trail — Open year-round!


LEA's Maine Lake Science Center trail system sits on 18 acres of woodlands and wetlands alongside Willett Brook in Bridgton, Maine. The extensive boardwalks are the product of two Eagle Scout projects. The property abuts 66-acre Pondicherry Park with the trails connecting in two locations.

The upper set of four low element challenge course stations were created and built along the Pinehaven Trail in the summer of 2018, with a generous donation by some LEA members. The lower three stations were funded by a generous grant from the Davis Conservation Foundation in 2019.

It is LEA's hope that people of all ages will find recreation in the outdoors, enjoy the beauty of the forest, and develop a sense of place while using our trails.

Directions: The Center is located at **51 Willett Road in Bridgton**. Coming into Bridgton on Route 302 from Naples, take a left at the traffic light near McDonalds. Go past Hannaford and the municipal garage on your right. Cross the brook and take an immediate right into the parking area. There is additional parking behind the Center in the "Event Parking" lot.
